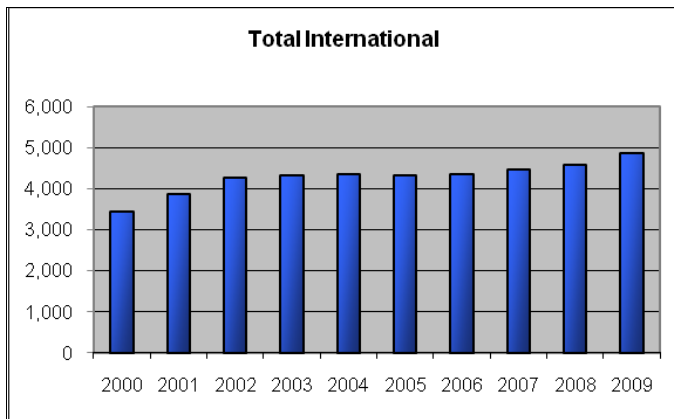

Student Enrollment

Based on 2008-09 data from the Institute of International Education (IIE) *Open Doors 2009* report, UM ranked sixth nationally among all universities (third among public research institutions) in terms of international students. The *Open Doors* report includes both enrolled students and those on Optional Practical Training (one-year work authorization after completion of studies). Therefore, *Open Doors 2009* indicates that UM “hosted” 5,790 international students in Fall Semester, 2008 and not the 4,574 reported as enrolled by the Office of the Registrar in 2008. In Fall Semester, 2009, U-M enrolled 4,855 international students from 111 countries.

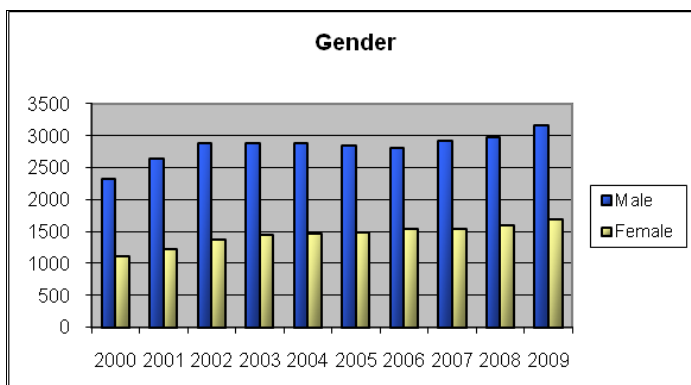

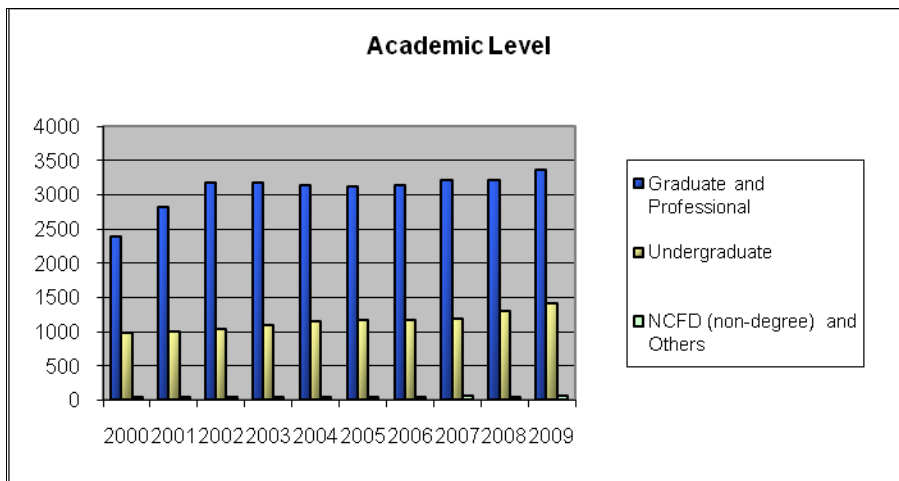

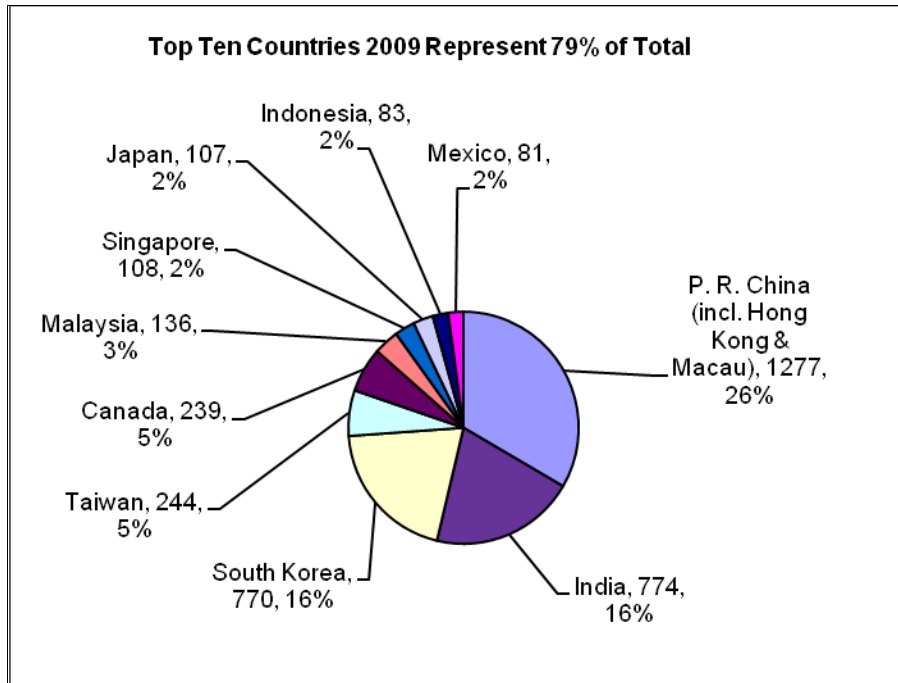

The IC handles all immigration paperwork for those on H-1B and J-1 visas and provides a wide range of services and programs for these individuals and their families. The IC also assists University departments by filing immigrant visa petitions for foreign nationals offered tenure track teaching positions and refers to outside counsel all others who are offered permanent employment at UM.

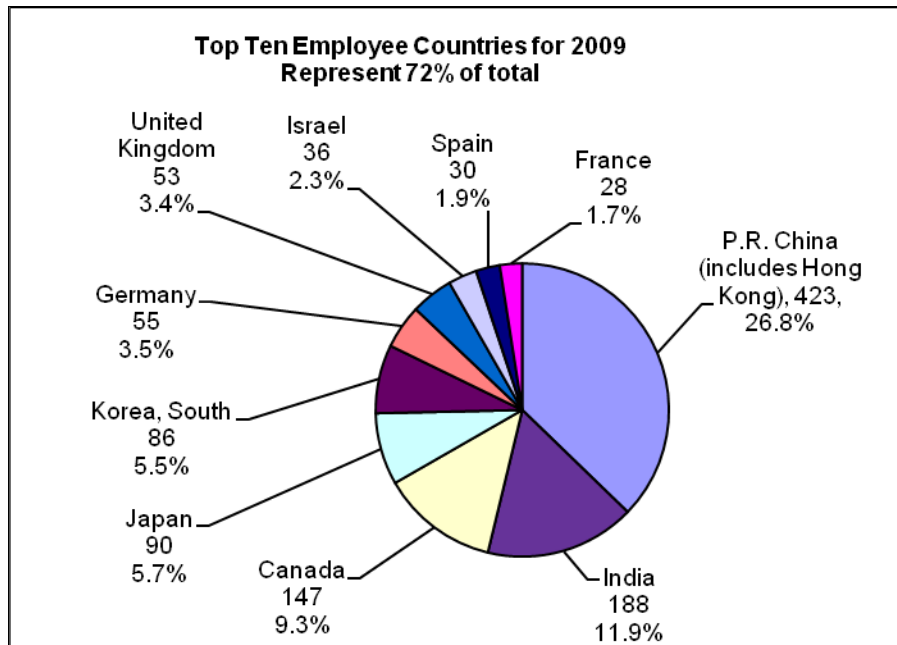

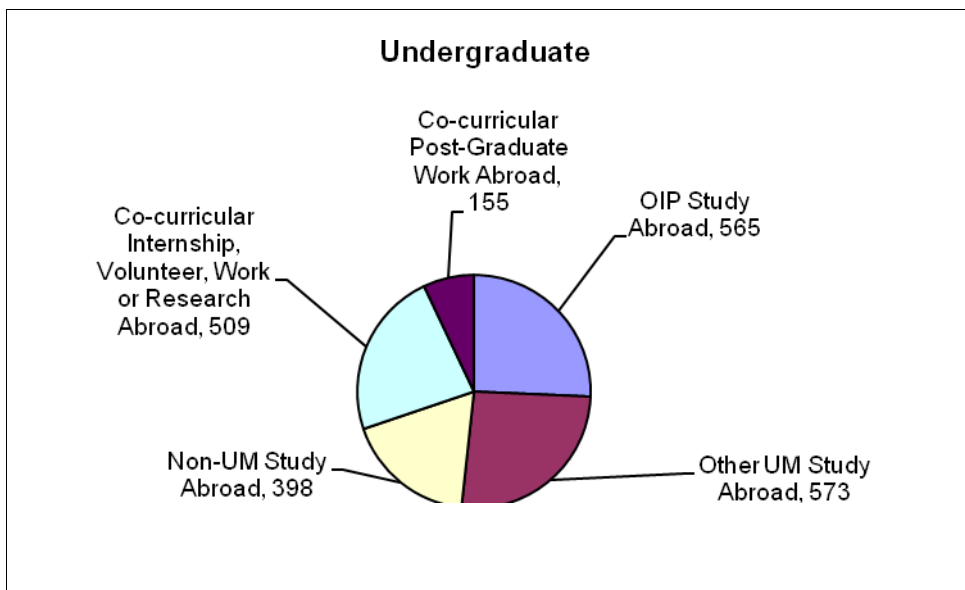

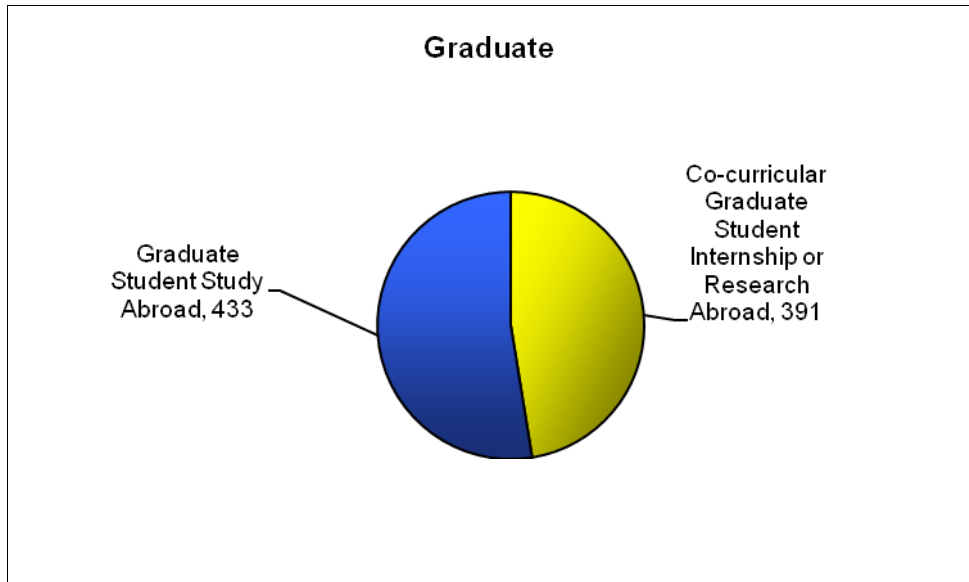
