

Great Lakes Crossing Outlets Shopping Trip



Location: [Auburn Hills](#) [2], Michigan

Cost: \$15/person for round trip transportation. **NO REFUNDS.** You will need to bring money for food and shopping. Students, scholars, friends, and families are welcome. Same price for all, regardless of age. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Latest News: *This trip is sold out and we do not keep a wait list. If you are unable to purchase a ticket and still wish to come, on the day of the trip, bring the exact amount of cash for the trip and meet us at one of the meeting locations. We cannot guarantee you will be able to get on the bus.*

Registration: In order to reserve your spot for this trip, you must pay in person at the [Michigan Union Ticket Office \(MUTO\)](#) [3] located in the [Michigan League](#) [4] underground level. Ask for the International Center's Great Lakes Crossing Outlets shopping trip. Cash or credit cards accepted. It is not possible to purchase tickets online. When purchasing the tickets, you must present a valid UMID and provide a phone number (in case of emergency during the trip). Limited space is available and each person is allowed to purchase up to two tickets.
